


Mark Your Calendars!

BFLC Staff Christmas Gift—It has been the practice for many years to invite special contributions from the members of the congregation towards a cash Christmas gift for the paid staff of BFLC. This includes the Pastors, Director of Ministries, Youth/Family Ministries Director, Administrative Assistant, Organists, Choir and Bells Director.

End of the Year - December 31—Donor must deliver or mail (postmark) on or by this date in order to claim a charitable contribution for 2021. Checks that are placed in the church offering during the first worship service on 2022 will not qualify for a charitable contribution deduction in 2021, even if the check is predated to 2021 or was actually written in 2021. However, checks that are written, mailed and postmarked in 2021 will be deductible in 2021, though they are not received by church until 2022.
