## Ready...Set...Play!



The BFLC Council recently approved the Property Committee's recommendation to replace the existing playground equipment, as its condition has become a safety concern. The work will begin this fall with the removal of the existing equipment, leveling and expanding the current play area and installation of additional fencing. In early 2023, the committee will partner with "Star Playgrounds" to select new play system components, finalize new surface material, and arrange for delivery and installation.

With this approval, we are initiating a formal fundraising campaign, with a target goal of \$40K. Yes, commercial play systems that meet safety standards are much more expensive than residential systems. The fundraising is already off to a great start. We've received just over \$11K to-date through funds made available following the anniversary dinner, proceeds from the Montie's yard sale, and several private donations in support of this project. Additional donations can now be made by noting "playground" in the memo section of your check.

La Puente is based in Alamosa and is their community's response to address the effects of poverty by providing a safety net of services, where individuals and families get what they need to stabilize, heal, strengthen, and ultimately thrive. BFLC has supported these efforts for many years with outreach in numerous ways, such as our quilters providing hand -made blankets during cold months, individuals donating warm clothing, coats, bedding, household items, and tools, and Social Ministry's project of providing hygiene bags twice each year.

Each time hygiene bags are delivered; it is clear what a true blessing these are to people in need in the San Luis Valley! The generosity of this congregation continues to amaze and overwhelm, and we thank you! It is time again in September to prepare the hygiene bags which will be delivered to Alamosa in the Fall. There will be a list of necessary items placed in a small bag on the bulletin board in Fellowship Hall. Please take one home. This is a list of suggestions for what is needed and any items on the list are appreciated in any amounts. Bath towels may be used but clean. La Puente is always appreciative of any clean bras, socks, new underwear, bandanas, stocking caps, warm head bands, warm shirts, blankets, etc. Items needed that you may not think of donating are those used in a simple sewing kit (needles, safety pins, buttons, small spools of thread).

Additional items specifically requested this year are long underwear for adult men or women and warm, insulated winter gloves (not mittens so they may work). Items may be place in the cart in Fellowship Hall and marked "La Puente".
