Volunteer Opportunity - Marian House

Marian House, operated by Catholic Charities, provides a daily noon meal to those in need. Right now, approximately 250-275 meals are served daily. In May, BFLC sponsored the meal along with Holy Trinity Catholic Church for one day. On the last Thursday and any 5th Saturday of a month, you will find several people from BFLC along with volunteers from Holy Trinity Catholic Church volunteering their time to prepare food for this nutritious meal and /or serving the meal to those in need. This occurs at Marian House located at 14 West Bijou in downtown Colorado Springs. Each congregation is asked to provide 10 volunteers per month. We have lost several volunteers in the past year due to illness and moving out of the area. Currently, we have 5-6 regular volunteers, but we need a few more to make the job easier for all. Food preparation begins at 7:00a, and serving the meal runs from 10:30a to 1:00p. Didi Panzo

Didi wants to thank everyone for their prayers and support of their mission work. There were four new mission locations opened in March and April, including Sanzi Mission. The city of Boma has suffered a huge loss as 3 major companies have closed, laying off over 15,000 workers. Some of them have turned to farming. The older population is having trouble getting food and Didi and Serafina brought food items to those people. The women of the choirs of the Lutheran church are living what they are learning, and they donated 24 chairs to Muanda Parish. Prayer requests:

- 1. For the high unemployment in the Congo that it can turn around.
- 2. For church leaders as they continue in their evangelism.
- 3. That God may provide for Didi and Serafina to travel to the USA in June for Serafina's checkup.
- 4. For getting an indefinite Visa which will not require any renewing when they travel out of the country. This is very expensive so pray that God will provide.

- Ladies of the Black Forest Women's Club: "Thank you so much for allowing us to use your fellowship hall. It means so much to us to be able to meet occasionally for fellowship!"


Playground Fundraiser
