A Big Thank You!

A sincere "thank you" to all who participated in the March 2, 2024, loading of the NALC disaster response truck. Once again, you've proven that you answer (even on very short notice) when called to help. We estimate 40 people participated in this event, moving 300+ buckets of cleaning supplies, 60 boxes of personal hygiene kits (~ 20 kits per box), 60 additional boxes of quilts, bibles, and baby supplies, and three very large (and very heavy) containers of shovels, rakes, and brooms. As many of you know all too well, these items are extremely important when dealing with the aftermath of a wildfire.

In September 2022, BFLC received a truckload of disaster response supplies from the NALC. The NALC supplies were designated for use in a future emergency. Well, that day arrived last Thursday, February 29. We were asked to load these NALC disaster response items into a large truck (which arrived at BFLC Saturday morning at 9am). On Sunday, this truck went to Gage, Oklahoma, where the supplies will be brought to areas in Texas, most impacted by the recent wildfires.

Your time and effort loading these NALC disaster response items will have a direct impact on people in those areas. Thank you for your generosity.

Compassionate Outreach Committee

One of the global outreach efforts supported by our Compassionate Outreach Committee is <u>El Porvenir</u>, an organization in action in Nicaragua to improve the lives of people in the second poorest country in the Western Hemisphere. El Porvenir has 4 primary mission goals of providing clean water, sanitation, reforestation, and fuel-efficient, vented stoves, primarily to people in rural areas.

A look at what El Porvenir provided in 2023 includes: 15,949 Nicaraguans served; 39,297 trees planted; 626 household water taps installed; 10 school handwashing stations; 404 toilets and latrines; 1,496 water quality tests; and 50 fuel-efficient vented stoves. El Porvenir strives to educate local Nicaraguans in order for them to educate others and pay it forward. Their hygiene education program had 14, 254 participants in 2023 and 30 out of 34 El Porvenir staff members are Nicaraguans.

One of El Porvenir's primary offices is located in Broomfield, Colorado, and our church contact person is a very personable Jenna Saldana. BFLC sponsored a project in 2021 to build 6 fuel-efficient vented stoves for 6 families. These vented stoves are so very necessary, as a staggering number of women in Nicaragua have lung cancer by the time they are 30 years old as a result of the smoke from burning wood used to cook in their homes. One of our own BFLC members has actually been a participant in building these stoves and has seen first-hand the impact our benevolence dollars make in the lives of these very grateful people!
